NOMINATIONS FOR TOWN COUNCIL (2 vacancies)**

- 1. Meeting to be called to order at 7:00 p.m.**
- 2. Introduction of the Board of Supervisors of Elections – Bruce Walz, Chairman, Ken Phebus, William Burke, and Nancy Hernandez, Alternate.**
- 3. Announcement that the notice for the Citizens' Meeting was placed in the Carroll County Times and Frederick News Post newspapers on February 20, 2010.**
- 4. Announcement of vacancies:**
  - **Office of Mayor which is currently held by Peter Helt.**
  - **Two Council seat vacancies which are currently held by Gary Nelson and Chris Everich.**
- 5. Qualifications for Mayor**
  - **Registered voter, Town resident for two years immediately prior to election. (C4-2)**
  - **At least 25 years of age. (C4-2)**
  - **Written consent to place name on the ballot. (5-6)**
  - **File a Financial Disclosure Statement within seven days of the nomination. (13-5C)**
- 6. Qualifications for Council position. (C2-2)**
  - **Registered voter, Town resident for one year prior to election,**
  - **Written consent to place name on the ballot (C5-6), and**
  - **File a Financial Disclosure Statement within seven days of the nomination. (13-5C)**
- 7. Nomination guidelines:**
  - **Need the correct name and address of the person nominated.**
  - **Need the name as it is to be placed on the ballot.**
  - **Nominations must be made by a citizen of the Town.**
  - **Need the name and address of person making nomination.**

### **10. Election Information:**

- **Election Day is Monday, May 3, 2010. Polling place is the Fireman's Activities Building on Twin Arch Road.**
- **Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.**
- **Last Day for registration - April 5, 2010.**
- **Last day to accept Write-In Candidates is April 12, 2010 at 5:00 p.m.**
- **Absentee Ballots will be available at Town Hall April 15, 2010. Voter must apply in writing stating their home address.**
- **Political Campaign signs are allowed with a maximum of six square feet provided that they are not placed in the public right-of-way. No permit is required but the name and address of the person responsible for the sign must be listed with the Town Permits Department.**
