

TOWN ADMINISTRATOR REPORT

April 2021

1-General Administration – As a wrap-up to the Federal CARES ACT (Covid Relief) the Town’s final expenditure and reimbursement amount was \$388,400.

The Town Staff has been working to provide, review and rank-order a variety of potential projects related to the \$7.9 million American Recovery funding that has been earmarked for the Town of Mount Airy. The results will be presented to the Mayor in the next few weeks.

It should also be noted that the Town staff’s collaborative departmental efforts to collect outstanding debts/expenses in the areas of Water & Sewer, Property Maintenance, Sidewalk Construction and Board of Appeals hearings has resulted in the payment of \$23,58.47 in past debt with some dating back as far as 2005.

2-Town Facilities - The Department of Public Works is gearing-up to begin preparing for Spring and Summer in the Town Parks. A Dedication Ceremony is being planned for April 9th regarding the inclusive playground.

3-Planning and Zoning – The staff have been working and meeting with various Commissions and Boards regarding the preliminary preparations for the 2023 Master Plan.

4-Community Development - The staff continues to work on securing all the grant funds via the Towns Program Open Space and the State Bond Bill for the CSX trail acquisition funding on March 24th.
