

**THE TOWN OF MOUNT AIRY
ORDINANCE NO. 2021-8**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2020-13, WHICH ADOPTED AND APPROVED THE BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF MOUNT AIRY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021.

FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE BUDGET BY REDUCING THE GENERAL FUND CAPITAL BUDGET BY \$490,000 FOR THE RAILS TO TRAILS - EAST OF MAIN STREET PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Rails to Trails – East of Main Street Project was included in the budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021; and

WHEREAS, the project did not move forward as expected, and had minimal expenses; and

WHEREAS, an effort is made to maintain an up-to-date budget plan that best reflects current and ongoing projects based on the projects actual progress; and

WHEREAS, from time to time the Town Council wishes to adjust the budget for large projects that did not progress as planned; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Mount Airy Adopted Ordinance 2020-13 adopting the Budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 for the Town of Mount Airy on June 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to amend Ordinance 2020-13 as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Mount Airy Budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 be, and hereby is, amended to reduce the General Fund Capital Project for Rails to Trails – East of Main Street by \$490,000, along with \$321,002 in Grant funding and \$168,998 from a Capital Improvement investment account; and that all other provisions of Ordinance 2020-13 shall remain unchanged and as is.
