

**THE TOWN OF MOUNT AIRY  
ORDINANCE NO. 2021-13**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2020-13, WHICH ADOPTED AND APPROVED THE BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF MOUNT AIRY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021.

FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE BUDGET BY REDUCING THE GENERAL FUND CAPITAL BUDGET BY \$400,000 FOR THE EAST WEST STORM WATER MANAGEMENT FACILITY PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the East West Storm Water Management Facility Project was included in the budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021; and

WHEREAS, the project is moving forward, however only about half of the allocation budgeted in Fiscal Year 2020-2021 will be spent; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to maintain an up-to-date budget plan that best reflects current and ongoing projects based on projects actual progress, the Town Council wishes to adjust the budget for large projects that did not progress as planned; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Mount Airy Adopted Ordinance 2020-13 adopting the Budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 for the Town of Mount Airy on June 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to amend Ordinance 2020-13 as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Mount Airy Budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 be, and hereby is, amended to reduce the General Fund Capital Project for East West Storm Water Management Facility by \$400,000, along with the funding from a Capital Improvements investment account; and that all other provisions of Ordinance 2020-13 shall remain unchanged and as is.
