

**THE TOWN OF MOUNT AIRY  
ORDINANCE NO. 2021-14**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2021-6, WHICH ADOPTED AND APPROVED THE BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF MOUNT AIRY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022.

FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE BUDGET BY REDUCING THE ADVERTISING EXPENSE IN THE GENERAL FUND OPERATING BUDGET LINE ITEMS FOR GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES AND DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION, AND THE WATER & SEWER FUND OPERATING BUDGET LINE ITEM FOR GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES BY A TOTAL REDUCTION OF \$12,000.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the allocations for advertising in the budget for Fiscal Year 2021 – 2022 has been over-estimated; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to adjust the budget to reflect a more accurate number; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Mount Airy Adopted Ordinance 2021-14 adopting the Budget for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 for the Town of Mount Airy on May 3, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to amend Ordinance 2021-14 as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Mount Airy Budget for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 be, and hereby is, amended in the following way:

1. The General Fund Operating line item for General Administrative expenses will be reduced by \$4,500 and the offsetting reduction will be transferred to the General Fund Operating Savings Account, and
  2. The General Fund Operating line item for Downtown Revitalization expenses will be reduced by \$5,000 and the offsetting reduction will be reallocated to the General Fund Operating line item for Park Enhancements to be used for a Pop-up Skate Park, and
  3. The Water & Sewer Fund Operating line item for General Administrative Expenses will be reduced by \$2,500 and the offsetting reduction will be transferred to the Water & Sewer Fund Operating Savings Account; and
- that all other provisions of Ordinance 2021-14 shall remain unchanged and as is.
